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The very French piano bar, Cozy - which we have nicknamed, in a good way, Sarkozy - located in the South of Fifth space formerly known as the Mark. The uber swanky space is intimate and, yes, cozy, and a bit pricey, too, with a menu that let you indulge in Foie Gras, caviar, tartar and cheese topped with tasteful deserts, as well as an exquisite drink menu. If you feel like a splurge, it's entirely worth going. In its infancy last week, the Gypsy Kings stopped by for an impromptu jam session. On Saturday, it was a soothing piano singer doing Sinatra. An ideal pre- or post-dinner place, Cozy exudes that je ne sais quoi.
